All abstracts must be submitted on e-mail icsr2016@outlook.com. Any abstract submitted on any other e-mail address will not be accepted. Any paper submitted to the ICSR should not be under consideration for publication at another conference or journal. All submitted papers must also represent original work. In an effort to prevent plagiarism, ICSR subscribes to CrossCheck to screen its submissions. CrossCheck has a "database of current and archival scholarly literature" and uses the Ithenticate tool to "compare authored work against the content in the database and highlight matching or similar text for further editorial review."

ICRS is unable to review manuscripts that have been previously rejected by the Scientific Journal for Theory and Practice of Socioeconomic Development SOCIOECONOMICA. ICSR reserves the right to reject papers without review.

All submissions, including revisions, must be accompanied by a Statement of authorship and financial disclosure. Submissions that do not include the statements will be considered incomplete and will not be reviewed.

Manuscript Preparations

- Page format is with standard A4 margins, each 2 cm wide.
- Papers are to be written in English language.
- Papers should be written in MS Word and the font should be Times New Roman.
- The main title should be in the middle of the first page in English (Font size 18pt)
- The author's name and surname should be below the title (Font size 14pt); the name and place of the author's institution should follow.
- The abstract should be maximum 100 words long. Abstract should also be written in English. Font size is 10pt.
- Key words, maximum 5.
- State the JEL paper qualification, available online at: www.aeaweb.org
- Headings and subheadings should be font size 14pt.
- The headers of tables, graphs, illustrations and so on, should be in Arabic numerals. Pictures, illustrations and graphs are to be .jpg file type (resolution 300*300 dpi). Pictures, illustrations and graphs are to be in black and white (grayscale). The font for text in pictures, illustrations and should be Arial, size 9pt.
- The maximal paper length is 50 pages.

ZLATIBOR

About Venue

Name ZLATIBOR (ZLATI=golden, BOR=pine) means "Golden Pine". On Zlatibor you can see many pine trees and that's the reason why people called this beautiful Serbian mountain as "Golden Pine Mountain". The Zlatibor Mt. is situated in the southwestern part of Serbia at the height from 700 to 1496 m above sea level (the highest peak is Tornik). The average height of Mt. Zlatibor is about 1000 m above sea level. It is intersected by numerous rivers, streams and ravines. Three highest peaks of Zlatibor massif are: Tornik (1.496m) - the highest peak of Zlatibor, Brijach (1.480m) and Chigota (1.422m).

Zlatibor is, first of all, an extraordinary beautiful mountain, with a pleasant climate, with spacious sloping grounds, rich pasture-grounds and mountain peaks. There are about 1000 square km of meadows and risings, sloping grounds and dry grounds, abysses and chasms...


